#### Overview:

During the Winter months, The Office of Bridge and Traffic Safety is focused on the following tasks:

- Winter Maintenance Operations
  - 80% of staff assigned to DPW garages during Winter Maintenance Operations
  - Remaining 20% of staff maintain bridge sidewalks
- Traffic Safety
  - Annual inspection/evaluation of all signs (14,000+) and pavement markings (12,00+)
  - o Scheduled sign replacements
  - Sign fabrication
- Signals:
  - Inspection of existing traffic signal systems
  - Deployment of variable message boards
- Bridge Crew
  - Bridge deck patching
  - Annual Bridge Maintenance inspections
  - Routine Monitoring
