

UPDATE- WINTER SEASONAL REPORT 2017-2018

The Division of Public Works operations focus resources toward continuous preparations and management of winter weather. Along with all of the preparation work described in our last Winter Seasonal Report our crews

- Responded to 20 storm events to date maintaining the County's' 65 snow plow routes across the 620 lane miles thus far this winter.
- Applied approximately 8,000 tons of salt.
- Stockpiled approximately 14,000 tons of grits and distributed throughout the County's 8 Salt Sheds.
