AWARENESS TIPS

The following indicators may point to possible terrorist use of self-storage units. Alone, each indicator can result from legitimate commercial activity or criminal activity not related to terrorism; however, multiple indicators combined with other factors can possibly suggest a terrorist threat.

- Insist on paying cash, weeks or months in advance.
- Seem overly concerned about privacy.
- Visits late at night or at unusual times.
- Exhibit suspicious behavior when approached by employees
- Unusual fumes, liquids, residues or odors emanating from storage units.
- Provide vague or irrational explanations of burns.
- Discard of chemical containers or storage of the following items:
 - Agricultural equipment, such as commercial sprayers.
 - o Explosives, blasting caps, or fuses.
 - o Weapons or ammunition.
 - o Flight manuals or similar materials.
 - o Laboratory materials.
 - Large delivery vehicles, vans, cargo containers, trailers or related equipment.
