A Look Back Highlights of 2008 January 2, 2009 During 2008 the County of Sussex, along with the rest of the nation, experienced some of the most troubling economic events in more than two generations. In response to, and in spite of, seemingly ever worsening economic news, the County set a course for even more efficient and effective services into the future



In August, the County's efforts were recognized by Standard & Poor's with an upgrade of the County's Bond rating specifically noting the County's "continued solid financial operations." The following pages highlight some of the accomplishments of 2008.

Sussex County 2008: A Look Back Commitment to Cost Effective Government



- Recognized State leader in shared services with taxpayer savings in 2008 exceeding \$1M
 - Integration of Vernon Health Dept. into County Health system completed(\$300K tax savings in Vernon)
 - Youth Shelter agreement with Morris County \$2.5M+ in tax savings over 5 year term
 - Agreement to provide road maintenance and storm service to Andover Borough
 - Continued discussions of 9-1-1 consolidation additional \$200K in grant funding secured

Sussex County 2008: A Look Back Commitment to Cost Effective Government



- Homestead Nursing Home
 - Improved case mix, resulting in increased Medicare and private pay revenue
 - Billing process reorganized to insure higher rate of return and reduction in receivables
- Restructured employee health benefits
 - Implemented self insured prescription benefit plan
 - Established self insured medical benefit plan

Sussex County 2008: A Look Back Green and Going Greener

- Preserved an additional 1,565 acres farmland (18 farms)
- Completed energy audits of major County facilities
- Purchased seven new heavy trucks at 100%+ increase in fuel efficiency
- Completed feasibility of analysis of solar
- Purchased first hybrid car with SHARE grant for use by Health inspectors
- Awarded contract for electronic document management system to reduce paper records and to allow easy public access to documents.



Sussex County 2008: A Look Back Rethinking Economic Development



- Commitment to redevelopment of downtown Newton
 - Grand re-opening of historic County Courthouse
 - Newton Main Street Partner
 - Completed sale of Hall of Records building returning property to local tax roll
 - Promoting Agriculture and Tourism
 - Farmer's Market Kitchen opened at Sussex Tech
 - Three Season Farmer's market building at Fairgrounds bid. Funded by Federal grant
- Advocate for municipal government
 - Sussex County Wastewater Management Plan submitted to NJDEP

 epidemic of obesity and related diseases.
- Hand washing education program created.
- 100% of retail food establishment inspections completed.
- Point of Dispensing (POD) clinic simulation held as preparation for a large- scale medical emergency requiring mass drug distribution.
