

## **VIII. Wastewater Facilities by Municipality:**

### *Walpack Township*

**2010 Population = 16 people**  
**Land Area = 24 square miles**

**2010 Population Density = 0.67 persons/sq. mile**

This municipal chapter is an element of the Sussex County Wastewater Management Plan prepared by Sussex County Planning Division in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15.

#### **Existing and Proposed Wastewater Infrastructure**

There is no existing or proposed wastewater infrastructure in Walpack Township. The vast majority of land in Walpack is Federally owned, part of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area.

#### **Build-out in Septic Areas and DEP Nitrate Dilution Model**

There is no current zoning ordinance in Walpack Township, and no land available for development. A Build-out analysis is not relevant for this parkland and was not done.

**Note: This municipality was erroneously listed as an “Urban Municipality” by DEP. The definition uses criteria of less than 10% developable land, and Walpack erroneously was included.**
