The Sussex County Social Services Food Pantry

Background: The Sussex County Food Pantry is one of many programs offered by the Division of Social Services. The food pantry offers immediate assistance to residents with no pre-qualification.

Q. Who does the food pantry serve?

A. The food pantry provides food to residents throughout Sussex County, as well as local food pantries whose shelves are often depleted due to the increasing demand for assistance.

Q. Do residents have to qualify for assistance from the food pantry?

A. There is no pre-qualification to receive assistance from the food pantry. Residents are only required to provide basic information such as the town in which they reside and the number of people in their family.

Q. What is the Backpack Snacks for Kids program?

A. The Backpack Snacks for Kids program provides Sussex County children with meals and snacks for the weekend. Items such as soup, oatmeal, granola bars, and applesauce are packaged in snack-size containers and distributed to children in participating school districts. The program helps ensure that children have a nutritious meal over the weekend or when they are on spring or summer break.

Q. Does the food pantry accept donations?

A. The food pantry operates through donations received from individuals, businesses, organizations, and community-wide events hosted by local radio stations, police departments, and schools throughout the year.

Q. Does the food pantry have volunteers?

A. The food pantry has approximately 20 consistent volunteers. The volunteers ensure that the "backend" of the food pantry operates smoothly and efficiently from unloading pallets, sorting and stacking food items, and the packing of bags. The volunteers donate their time and labor consistently at least twice a week and often times more.

Sussex County Social Services Food Pantry Fun Facts

- The pantry serves approximately 20,140 people annually.
- Approximately 25,200 backpack snack bags are distributed to children in local schools.
- All donations remain in Sussex County.

Property Alert



Q. What is the purpose of the Property Alert Service?

A. The Property Alert Service is an ALERT (not preventative) service that will alert registered property owners via email if a document that affects a specific property is recorded by our office.

Q. Is there a fee for the Property Alert Service?

A. No. This is a free service provided by the Sussex County Clerk's Office.

Q. What do I need to register for Property Alert?

A. You will need an email address, your lot & block #, and property owner name(s).

Q. Why should I register for this service?

A. In some cases, fraud on real property is not discovered for years. This service helps to notify property owners in a more timely fashion.

Q. Why can't you stop the fraudulent document from being recorded?

A. As long as a document meets statutory recording guidelines, New Jersey law requires the Clerk's Office to record the document. Recordings cannot be refused unless guidelines are not met.

Q. What do I do if a fraudulent document was recorded with my property information?

A. If you find a document recorded against your name or property is fraudulent, you should contact your attorney or prosecutor's office.

County Government Information

~WHAT IS A COMMISSIONER? ~

A Commissioner is the elected county government representative in New Jersey who serves on the county's main governing body, the Board of County Commissioners.

The Sussex County Board of County Commissioners sets policy for five County departments and 13 divisions, plus a number of boards, commissions, authorities and committees. The Commissioners appoint a County Administrator to supervise the actual day-to-day operation of county government.

~COUNTY GOVERNMENT IN NEW JERSEY~

The basic law establishing the Commissioner (previously termed "Chosen Freeholder" in New Jersey until the year 2020) form of county government in New Jersey was enacted in 1798. In the beginning, each corporate municipality was represented by a Freeholder on the county governing board. But as the number of municipalities increased to the point where some Boards were bogged down by sheer weight of numbers, the law was changed. In 1912 the "Small Board" Act was adopted, permitting counties to elect Freeholders from the county at large. The exact number of Freeholders making up each county Board was to be determined by the respective county's population. The law was permissive, and subject to approval by the voters at a referendum.

In 2020, New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy signed legislation which requires the title of "Chosen Freeholder" to be changed to "County Commissioner" and all "Boards of Chosen Freeholders" to be known as "Boards of County Commissioners" within one year of the bill's effective date, January 1, 2021.

County Government Information

Sussex County has five Commissioners. A county may have between three and nine, depending on its population and classification.

The Commissioners are elected at-large to serve three-year staggered terms. The five Commissioners elect a Director and Deputy Director from among themselves to run their meetings and to serve as spokesperson for the Board
