PUBLIC HEALTH ALERT! RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS

TO: All Retail Food Establishments

Subject: COVID-19 (Coronavirus) – Governor's Executive Order

In order to slow the spread of COVID-19, New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy issued an Executive Order for Retail Food Establishments, effective March 16, 2020 at 8PM until further notice:

- All restaurants and bars are limited to offering delivery and/or take-out services (including drive-thrus) only. **NO DINE-IN CUSTOMERS. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Supermarkets, grocery stores, and pharmacies will remain open.

Other reminders:

- Wash your hands often with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Avoid close contact. Put distance between yourself and other people (six feet or more).
- Stay home if you are sick, except to get medical care.
- Clean and disinfect <u>frequently touched surfaces</u> often. This includes coffee self-serve stations, other customer service areas, tables, doorknobs, light switches, customer area countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
