(**Hardyston, NJ**) Sussex County Freeholder Director Sylvia Petillo is saddened to announce five additional COVID-19- related deaths in Sussex County, in a 68 year- old female from Hampton Township, a 90 year- old female from Newton Town, a 94 year- old female from Newton Town, a 78 year- old male from Andover Township, and an 86 year- old male from Andover Township. The Sussex County Division of Health (SCDOH) has been working with those individuals who came into contact with these patients. Those identified as close contacts are in their homes under self-quarantine and being monitored by the SCDOH staff.

The Sussex County Board of Chosen Freeholders and the Sussex County Division of Health extend their condolences to the patients' families and friends during this difficult time. The SCDOH is taking all possible steps to ensure the health and safety of our community, and asks for the public's cooperation in following all recommendations put forth by county, state, and federal agencies.
