2019 Novel Coronavirus

(Hardyston, NJ) From 12:01 AM on March 12, 2021 to 12:00 AM on March 15, 2021 the Sussex County Division of Health (SCDOH) announces 163 additional cases of COVID-19 among County residents, with an average of 54 cases daily, for a total number of 10,500* confirmed cases. Of the 10,500* cases, 9,141 cases have been classified as recovered. Additionally, the SCDOH reports no new deaths for a total of 278 deaths.
