 - **B.** CT Colonography (Virtual Colonoscopy)
 - C. Pap Test
 - **D.** Stool Tests

Answer: C. Pap tests screen for cervical cancer.

- 5. True or false: Tanning indoors is safer than tanning in the sun.
 - A. True
 - B. False

Answer: B. Both are dangerous.

- 6. Which of the following is not linked to an elevated lung cancer risk:
 - A. Cigarette smoking
 - B. Radon
 - **C.** Smokeless tobacco products
 - D. None of the above

Answer: D
