2017-2018 WINTER SEASON OPERATIONS – END SEASON REPORT

November, December, January, February 2017

Overview:

The Division of Public Works operations focus resources toward continuous preparations and management of winter weather. Along with all of the preparation work described in our last Winter Seasonal Report our crews have/are:

- Responded to 35 storm events maintaining the County’s’ 65 snow plow routes across the 620 lane miles this winter.
- Applied approximately 21,500 tons of salt.
- Stockpiled approximately 14,500 tons of grits and distributed throughout the County’s 8 Salt Sheds.

Continuing to maintain the County’s 620 lane miles during winter events.
