**PROJECT UPDATE NOTICE**

**Project:**

Asphalt wearing surface Crack Sealing is a core component of the Sussex County pavement maintenance program. Crack Sealing extends the useful service life of a roadway by limiting the infiltration of water into the pavement structure. Work locations are selected based upon an evaluation of pavement conditions, traffic volumes, and in coordination with other roadway maintenance activities.

**Construction Forces:**

- Sussex County Division of Public Works

**Project Funding:**

- 100% Sussex County Capital Funds
- Projected expenses for material and rental equipment: \$45,000
- Miles of Road in 2018 Program: 51 +/-

**Work Schedule:**

**Work will be conducted under single lane closures with flagging operations. Work is scheduled to continue through the month of October.**
