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PROJECT STARTUP NOTICE

Project:

Advances the annual Sussex County Long Line Striping maintenance program which includes restriping Epoxy or Latex Lines on various sections of County Routes. On average epoxy long lines will provide 2-4 years of service life. Work will occur in various townships within Sussex County.

Contract & Funding:

- 100% Sussex County Operating Funds
- Approximate Cost per Mile Epoxy: \$6,336.00
- Total Miles of Epoxy Restripe: 70 miles +/-
- Approximate Cost per Mile Latex: \$2,006.40
- Total Miles of Latex Restripe: 37 miles +/-
- Total Program Budget: \$515,000.00 +/-
