Bridge X-48 Replacement

ADVANCED TRAFFIC ADVISORY FOR GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATION Currently Scheduled for Monday, October 28 thru Wednesday, October 30

## Project:

Replacement of the 28-ft long, steel girder and open grid deck Bridge X-48 on Mudtown Road in Wantage Township.

To properly evaluate the existing subsurface conditions for the design of a new replacement bridge, accurate information about the subsurface soil conditions at the bridge must be obtained.

Therefore, a truck mounted drilling rig (see adjacent sample photo) will be mobilized at this location to conduct a geotechnical investigation (See below for further details of traffic impacts).

## What & Where:

Mudtown Road will remain **open** to through traffic at Bridge X-48 during the geotechnical engineering investigation, utilizing a single lane closure and flagging operation. Access to driveways and municipal roads will be maintained throughout the duration of the operation.


## When:

The geotechnical investigation is expected to take up to two days with traffic delays expected between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM each day.
