Ambulance Companies:

AWARENESS TIPS

The following indicators may point to possible terrorist activities. Alone, each indicator can result from legitimate activity or criminal activity not related to a terrorist; however, multiple indicators can suggest a terrorist threat.

- *Theft or loss of equipment associated with ambulances.*
 - *Medical Paraphernalia*
 - *Uniforms*
 - *Insignias/Decals*
 - *Vehicle License Plate(s)*
 - *Special Parking Placards*
 - *Identification*
- *Unexplained withdrawal by a student after completion of a training/certification program requisite to the operation of an ambulance and associated duties.*
- *Inquires into the purchase of an ambulance vehicle.*
- *Suspicious Individuals observed in the vicinity of parked ambulances.*
