AWARENESS TIPS

The following indicators *may* point to possible terrorist activities. *Alone, each indicator can result from legitimate activity or criminal activity not related to terrorism; however, multiple indicators combined with other factors can possibly suggest a terrorist threat.*

- **The unexpected withdrawal -- in mid-semester -- of a child because his/her family is suddenly returning to their former country overseas.**
- **Unusual inquiries (telephone, in-person) from strangers regarding school hours (e.g., arrival and dismissal times), pupil attendance/population (e.g., ethnic/religious composition of the student body), the presence of security measures in place (or lack thereof), etc.**
- **Queries made by individuals who do not appear to be interested in registering their children.**
- **Reports of someone videotaping or photographing the school building or making observations of the activity relating to school functions.**
- **Ominous statements made by a student regarding an approaching date.**
- **Parking of a suspicious vehicle in the school's parking lot or in close proximity to the school building.**
