AWARENESS TIPS

The following indicators *may* point to possible terrorist use of self-storage units. *Alone, each indicator can result from legitimate commercial activity or criminal activity not related to terrorism; however, multiple indicators combined with other factors can possibly suggest a terrorist threat.*

- **Insist on paying cash, weeks or months in advance.**
- **Seem overly concerned about privacy.**
- **Visits late at night or at unusual times.**
- **Exhibit suspicious behavior when approached by employees**
- **Unusual fumes, liquids, residues or odors emanating from storage units.**
- **Provide vague or irrational explanations of burns.**
- **Discard of chemical containers or storage of the following items:**
 - **Agricultural equipment, such as commercial sprayers.**
 - **Explosives, blasting caps, or fuses.**
 - **Weapons or ammunition.**
 - **Flight manuals or similar materials.**
 - **Laboratory materials.**
 - **Large delivery vehicles, vans, cargo containers, trailers or related equipment.**
